4.2 | Decision

4.2.1 | Decision Summary

The request for deviation against the minimum site visit requirements for GS7140 is not approved.

The secretariat notes that the site visit must have been completed by 26th July 2024. The Secretariat does not consider the reasons provided by the Project Developer to be sufficient justification for waiving the site visit and verification requirement. The secretariat is not able to conclude that the project area faced extreme weather conditions in/before July 2024. Thus, the delay pointed out cannot be considered as a delay due to force majeure.

The Project Developer must follow the requirements in the Site Visit and Remote Audit Requirements and Procedures.

Summarise the changes	According to the "Applicability of Minimum Site Visit Requirements by VVB," para 2.2.3 (ii), VVB shall not verify the monitoring period falling before three years of the site visit date. Accordingly, the follow-up visit was required to be completed by 26/07/2024. Exceeding the prescribed timeline, the physical site visit was conducted on 04/04/2025 and 05/04/2025, in addition to the previous visit held on 27/07/2021. As a result, GS-VERs generated from 01/01/2021 to 03/04/2022 cannot be verified by VVB. Even though, a remote site visit was also conducted by the VVB on 12/10/2023 during design certification renewal.	
Reason for deviation	50 MW Telangana, Nalgonda district: The delay in conducting the required follow-up physical site visit occurred due to extreme and prolonged weather conditions in Telangana, Nalgonda district which qualify as Force Majeure type events. Some links are provided below to cross check: As per Indian Meteorological Department (IMD) (https://www.newindianexpress.com/states/teelangana/2024/Jul/17/imd-issues-orange-alert-in-teelangana-till-july-20?utm) : IMD issued an orange alert for heavy rain and thunderstorms across Telangana, including Nalgonda district, with forecasts of gusty winds and isolated heavy showers as the southwest monsoon was active. As per Telangana today: (https://telanganatoday.com/nalgonda-in-teelangana-records-highest-rainfall-since-1979?utm) : The Nalgonda area in Telangana experienced exceptionally heavy rainfall in September 2024, with parts of the district recording some of the <i>highest rainfall totals seen in decades</i> — up to ~29.6 cm in a 12-hour period, the highest since 1979. These intense downpours led to significant waterlogging, disruptions to transport, and at least one fatality, as families were stranded and low-lying zones inundated Moderate to heavy rain reported across Nalgonda district (Sept 2024) — showing rainfall activity around that timeframe.(https://www.deccanchronicle.com/southern-states/teelangana/moderate-to-heavy-rain-in-nalgonda-district-1820553?utm) 10 MW Karnataka, Yadgir district As per IMB (	

	https://internal.imd.gov.in/press_release/20240925_pr_3293.pdf?utm) Official weather forecasts and IMD bulletins in late September 2024 indicated widespread rain activity over Karnataka including interior regions such as Yadgir. Due to both these site conditions flooding, waterlogged access roads, thunderstorm warnings, and general safety hazards, the physical site visit had to be repeatedly postponed since July 2024, despite multiple attempts to schedule it. These extreme weather events were entirely beyond the control of the Project Developer and made site access unsafe for both project personnel and auditors. Given the continued heavy rainfall, persistent storm activity, and repeated official weather alerts, the Project Developer respectfully requests approval to claim GS-VERs for the period 01/01/2021 to 03/04/2022, recognizing that the delay was caused solely by unavoidable Force Majeure circumstances. All efforts were made to maintain compliance with GS requirements while prioritizing the safety of all stakeholders.				
Proposed resolution	The deviation is requested to allow the project developer (PD) to claim GSVERs for the period from 01/01/2021 to 03/04/2022, The project activity was continuously operational since commissioning and has been generating GS-VERs throughout the period. The project has consistently maintained its operational status under the Gold Standard framework, justifying the request for deviation to recognize the credits generated during this timeframe.
