3.1.1 | Deviation detail (to be completed by Project developer):

GS3411 Akbük II Wind Farm Project” started its registration activities with the consultancy agreement signed with Life Enerji on 19/11/2019. Since then, the project has been trying to complete its design certification by GS. The project has lost considerable time due to the late returns of the VVB and the validation report submitted to the system on 15/11/2021. However, Project Proponent made payment for the initiation of the GS Review on 24/11/2021, which is one day later than the deadline of 23/11/2021 stipulated in the 3.1.12 Paragraph of the “Transition Requirements” document (dated 16/08/2021) for the projects that are listed status before 01/07/2017. The main reason for missing the deadline is that the Project Proponent is a big corporate company and invoice processing requires multiple touchpoints. The payment invoices are first forwarded to the accounting unit of the company. And it takes time for the accounting unit of the company to review the payment notice and take action towards paying. Since the due date of SustainCERT’s invoice was given as 24/11/2021, the accounting unit considered this date written on the invoice. For all of these reasons, the payment was conducted on 24/11/2021. As the delay is only one day and payment is made as per SustainCERT’s invoice deadline, we kindly ask you to provide an exemption for the submission requirement deadline since the project has been trying to register for two years. Please also consider that eventually, the invoice was paid to SustainCERT’s account within the same week of 23 November, and there were some problems due to the launch of the new portal of SustainCERT, which was offline for four days.
