The project developer through this submission would like to <u>request an extension to</u> <u>submit the SCR for the 2nd VPA in Zimbabwe for the PoA GS 10875.</u> The stakeholder's meeting was carried out in line with GS rules in the month of September 2021, but the PD did not submit the stakeholder's consultation report to SC till Jan 2023.

In line with clause, 4.1.35 of the P & R requirements, the project shall prepare the Stakeholder consultation report of the consultation process, including consultation feedback and how this was incorporated into the design of the Project. The Stakeholder consultation report shall be submitted to Gold Standard within three months of the event (though this date may be after the Project Start Date).

There was delay in submission of the SCR since there was no progress made in the 2nd VPA with respect to implementation of the project activity i.e. project is yet to start as of now. The delay of the 2nd VPA is attributable to the delay in Design certification of the PoA (GS 10875) and the 1st VPA in Zimbabwe (GS 11343) which occurred on 22nd Dec, 2022. Due to delay of the project achieving design certification status, there was a lack of clarity with respect to achieving investments required to implement the 2nd VPA. The issue has now been resolved since the 1st VPA has now achieved Design Certification status and implementation related to the 2nd VPA shall soon be underway.
