3.1.1 | Deviation detail (to be completed by Project developer):

This deviation request is about an extension for the Gold Standard Project 6193: Sakarya Landfill Gas Power Plant project.

According to Clause 3.1 of the Site Visit and Remote Audit Requirement and Procedures document, "Frequency of physical site visits", as per sub clause 3.1.2 "Once within every three years after the first physical site visit date". The project in contention had its last site visit from the VVB on 26<sup>th</sup> February 2020 and, going by the Clause as stated above, should have had its next site visit before the 26<sup>th</sup> February 2023.

However, due to delay by the contracted VVB in undergoing the validation of the project and providing the validation report, coupled with COVID-19 pandemic which and due to other reasons beyond the control of the project owner, the site visit did not take place within the timeline. The auditor at the VVB has left, did not reply to ClimeTrek's emails and so the new auditor could not start reviewing the project. It took some time for the new auditor at the VVB to get familiarized with the project which has delayed the entire process.

The project has now successfully completed the Design Review, and it is now in the process of assigning a new VVB for the Performance Review and its subsequent physical visit for the first verification.

Owing to such a circumstance, we are requesting an extension of nine months for the next site visit for us to complete the Performance Review. The Project Owner has provided a signed declaration stating that there has been no deviation in the project activity since the start of the project.

Thus, on behalf of the Project Owner i.e., Sakarya Entegre Kati Atik Yonetimi Anonim Sirketi, and being the Project Representative on this project, we request you to grant us this extension such that the project can complete its performance review. We would request you to treat this subject on a priority basis and assist us on an immediate basis.
