1.2 | Decision

The deviation request is APPROVED as the CME has conducted the physical meeting and extended feedback in the same month to inform the relevant stakeholders.

However, CME shall note that the Stakeholder Feedback Round has to be conducted for 60 days after the physical stakeholder consultation since this is a regular project activity, where as the conducted feedback was for 45 days. Hence in line with p. 3.6.13 of Stakeholder consultation and engagement requirements, CME may organize the Stakeholder Feedback Round for the prescribed duration in parallel to the validation process, however before concluding the validation opinion, the VVB shall take into account the feedback and how the comments were addressed and any potential revision in the project design and documentation. The validating VVB shall however confirm that the CME has made sufficient efforts to reach out to all the relevant stakeholders to inform them about the stakeholder meeting and collect their feedback. The VVB shall include their assessment and opinion on the same in the GS validation report.

SustainCert shall review both the CME's response and the VVB's assessment/opinion of the same and take appropriate steps.

This deviation deals with the PayGo LPG cookstove project (GS11725) and its stakeholder consultation. Gold Standard requirements state that invitations for the stakeholder consultation must be sent at least 30 days prior to the meeting. In this case, the date of the consultation was set to maximize in person participation after the recent removal of workplace and mass gathering restrictions (link). From a logistical perspective, there was a spike in COVID cases (link) after the removal of restrictions and there were rumors that restrictions were going to be put back as the case numbers increased. Therefore, the decision was made to go ahead with the in person event that had significant representation from pilot customers, community groups and industry stakeholders. Some emails and personal invites were sent out early, but due to a delay, many of the invitations were sent out about three weeks prior to the event instead of the required 30 days. Despite this issue, the following should be noted:

• The length of the overall feedback round lasted more than a month after the initial stakeholder meeting (19th May), giving people time to submit any concerns.

 There was still robust participation as 45% of the people who received an invitation came to the meeting. The questions from the participants and how that feedback was taken into account for the overall project design are available in the Stakeholder Consultation Report (<u>https://platform.sustaincert.com/public-project/3217</u>)

- For those who were not able to attend the session, follow up emails were sent, seeking any feedback or questions these stakeholders may have had. PayGo received 0 responses from participants that did not attend.
- The Continuous Input/Grievance Mechanism is still provided for stakeholders if they wish to utilize it. *PayGo Energy will have a dedicated customer service number to handle customer issues, as well as a 24/7 line in case of emergencies.*
- Subsequent to the in-person consultation, no specific issues or grievances have been raised, indicating that stakeholders are generally satisfied with the overall PayGo project. And everyone who received an invitation less than 30 days prior to the meeting have had multiple opportunities to provide feedback.
