INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the User Guide for the Gold Standard Digital SDG Impact Tool. This guide is designed to help you understand and use the various features and functionalities of the web application effectively. This guide will tackle the Host Country user and the respective features and workflows in the SDG Impact Tool.

GETTING STARTED

IMPACT REGISTRY

Upon landing on the [SDG Impact Tool](#), users will see a “Sign In” button and an “Impact Registry” button. The “Sign In” button will direct the user to the Login or Register page of the SDG Impact Tool, the “Impact Registry” button will direct the user to the Gold Standard Impact Registry website.

Registration and Login

There are two ways in which a new user can register and then subsequently login to the SDG Impact Tool:

1. New Users (via Email)

To access the Gold Standard SDG Impact Tool using email, you need to create an account by following these steps:

1. Open the [web application](#) in your preferred web browser.
2. Click on the "Sign In" button.
3. In the following page, click on the “Don't have an account? Sign up” button
4. Fill in the required information: email address, and password.
5. Click on the "Continue" button
6. A page shall display “Your account is pending approval”, please click the link and complete the subscription form
7. Check your email inbox for a verification link.

8. Click on the verification link to activate your account.
9. Wait for the Gold Standard Administrator to approve your request
10. Once approved, return to the web application and log in using your registered email and password.

2. New Users (via Google Login)

To access the Gold Standard SDG Impact Tool using your Google Account, you need to create an account by following these steps:

1. Open the [web application](#) in your preferred web browser.
2. Click on the "Sign In" button
3. In the following page, click on the "Continue with Google" button and follow the steps to authorise your Google account
4. A page shall display "Your account is pending approval", please click the link and complete the subscription form
5. Wait for the Gold Standard Administrator to approve your request
6. Once approved, return to the web application and log in using the "Continue with Google" button.

HOST COUNTRY USER

This section describes the main features of the SDG Impact Tool for Host Country Users. Each feature includes sub-features that provide detailed information on how to use them effectively.

Features

Objectives Page

The objectives page is designed for host country entity users to conveniently declare the SDG Monitoring Indicators as host country objectives. Host Country users can select from the list of SDG Impact Indicators to declare as their host country objectives. They can select the indicator either at the SDG level, the Target level or the Indicator level.

Setting SDG Objectives

1. On the Objectives Page, click the “SET” button on the top right of the “Host Country Objectives” section to begin the process of selecting the Host Country Objectives.
2. Select the SDG to view the Target and Indicators under the selected SDG.

SDG 1: End poverty in all its forms everywhere

- 1.1 By 2030, eradicate extreme poverty for all people everywhere, currently measured as people living on less than \$1.25 a day
 - GSDG-I1.1.1 Proportion of the population living below the international poverty line by sex, age, employment status and geographic location (urban/rural)
 - GSDM-I1.1.1 decrease in expenditure on basic service such cooking, lighting, drinking
- 1.2 By 2030, reduce at least by half the proportion of men, women and children of all ages living in poverty in all its dimensions according to national definitions
 - GSDG-I1.2.1 Proportion of population living below the national poverty line, by sex and age
 - GSDG-I1.2.2 Proportion of men, women and children of all ages living in poverty in all its dimensions according to national definitions
- 1.3 Implement nationally appropriate social protection systems and measures for all, including floors, and by 2030 achieve substantial coverage of the poor and the vulnerable
 - GSDG-I1.3.1 Proportion of population covered by social protection floors/systems, by sex, distinguishing children, unemployed persons, older persons, persons with disabilities, pregnant women, newborns, work-injury victims and the poor and the vulnerable
- 1.4 By 2030, ensure that all men and women, in particular the poor and the vulnerable, have equal rights to economic resources, as well as access to basic services, ownership and control over land and other forms of property, inheritance, natural resources, appropriate new technology and financial services.
 - GSDG-I1.4.1 Proportion of population living in households with access to basic services
 - GSDG-I1.4.2 Proportion of total adult population with secure tenure rights to land, (a) with legally recognized documentation, and (b) who perceive their rights to land as secure, by sex and type of tenure

3. Users can choose to select and deselect Indicators and Targets under the SDG.
4. Users can also select/deselect ALL Targets and Indicators.

5. Once done with selection, click the “SAVE” button at the bottom of the page.
6. Objectives should now be displayed in the main Objectives page.
