USAGE RATE REQUIREMENTS-TECHNOLOGIES AND PRACTICES TO DISPLACE DECENTRALIZED THERMAL ENERGY CONSUMPTION

BACKGROUND

Standalone improved cooking projects applying the Gold Standard's Technologies and Practices to Displace Decentralized Thermal Energy Consumption methodology are required to mandatorily comply with the <u>Requirements and Guidelines for carrying out Usage Surveys for projects implementing improved cooking devices</u> (dated 23/08/.2017), hereafter <u>"Usage requirements"</u>.

This methodology rule update expands the scope of applicability of the current usage requirements to Household Biogas Digesters.

RULE UPDATE

All new and registered projects and Programmes of Activities (PoAs)/VPAs, involving household biogas digesters and/or improved cooking devices and applying the Gold Standard's Technologies and Practices to Displace Decentralized Thermal Energy Consumption (TPDDTEC) methodology, the ADALYs methodology and/or Black Carbon methodology shall be required to apply the usage requirements.

Applicability

All new and registered projects and PoAs/VPAs of all scales involving the implementation/operation of household biogas digesters and/or improved cooking devices applying the TPDDTEC methodology.

Entry Into force

- For projects and PoAs/VPAs involving improved cooking devices, there is no change from the usage requirements dated 23/08/2017.
- New Projects and PoA/VPAs involving household biogas digesters submitted for Design Certification after 01/01/2021 shall design the monitoring plan as per Usage Requirements v.2.0.
- Registered Projects and PoA/VPAs involving household biogas digesters, with monitoring periods after 26/10/2021, must demonstrate compliance with Usage Requirements v.2.0. The project/PoA/VPAs can submit the revised monitoring plan with issuance requests submitted before 26/10/2021.
